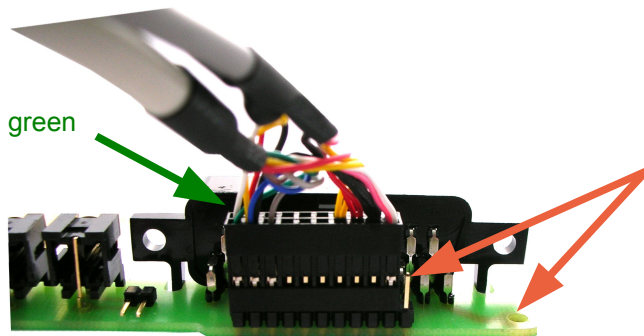


Internal Scart connector cable

for PVR 500/1300 with some modifications

Optional shield:
to improve sound and video quality, please connect it with a metal part of the chassis.

Step 1: Connect the white plug with the WinTV
Step 2: Connect the black plug to the Scart connector.
The green cable (wire no. 1 with Pin no. 1)

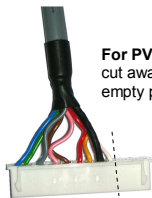

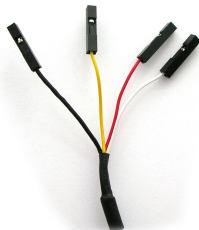
Video-In
(S-Video or
Composite-Video)



For PVR-500/ 1300 only:
cut away the unused
empty part of the white plug

If you use the Scart for Video-In, please connect it with your tv card.

Video-Out
(S-Video or
Composite-Video)



If your motherboard or VGA has an internal Video-Out, then you can connect it to the Scart.

Black: Shield/ Ground
Yellow: Ground
Red: C-channel S-Video
White: Composite Video or
Y-channel S-Video

Sound-Out



If you use Video-Out, you should also connect Audio-Out to Scart.

White: Right Channel
Black: Ground
Yellow: Ground
Red: Left channel
